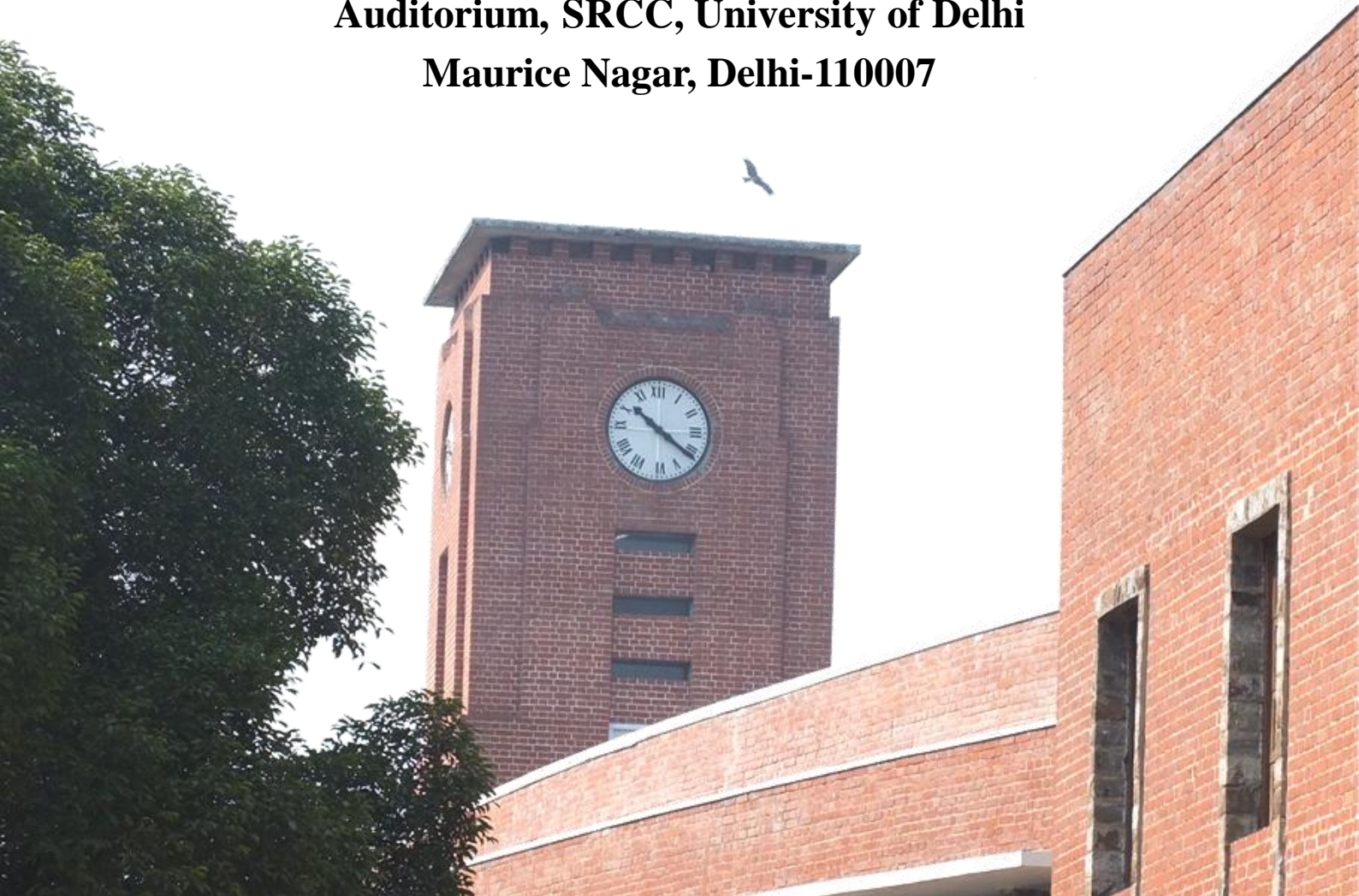

While tertiary education is central to all four pillars of this framework, its role is particularly crucial in building a strong human capital base and contributing to an efficient national innovation system. As such, in the past decade, the apposite term '*World-Class Institutions*' has become the underlying denomination to represent the evolution of educational institutions in the expansion of their role from improving the quality of learning and research in tertiary education to their inclusive engagement in simultaneously developing and nurturing the capacity to compete in the global tertiary education marketplace through the creation, acquisition, adaptation, transmission and spread of advanced knowledge.
