

Conference Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

1. How do I submit abstract of my proposed research paper?

Abstract is to be submitted at srcicew@srcc.edu.ac.in by June 25th, 2018 before 5:00 p.m. It must contain an introduction, objectives, research methodology, data sources and the outcomes. It should be restricted to maximum 500 words (excluding references), highlighting five major keywords.

2. How and when will I know the acceptance of the work submitted by me?

Decision as to acceptance/rejection of the work submitted shall be notified through email by June 25, 2018.

3. What are the important dates for submission and registration?

June 21, 2018	Last date for submission of abstracts before 5:00 p.m.
June 25, 2018	Notification of acceptance of abstracts (An earlier decision will be communicated to International presenters)
July 10, 2018	Last date for submission of full paper
July 05, 2018	Last date for early bird registration and fees deposit

4. Which referencing style shall I follow for my research paper?

APA (American Psychological Association) style of referencing is preferred.

5. What is the procedure to pay registration fee?

Registration fees can be paid through RTGS, NEFT, Debit cards or Credit cards. For bank details, please refer to the conference brochure: <http://www.srcc.edu/sites/default/files/brochure-final-min.pdf>

6. What is included in the registration fee?

Registration fee includes lunch and coffee breaks on the days of the conference, delegate kit, an electronic copy of the conference proceedings.

7. Can I register now and pay later?

Yes, one can register now and pay later.

8. Can I revise my full paper after submission but before the last date?

Yes, one can revise the paper before the last date. The latest submission will be taken as a final submission.

9. Is there any limit to the number of authors of a research paper?

There is no limit as to the number of authors in a research paper.

10. Can a participant submit more than one abstract/ research paper for the Conference?

Yes, a participant can submit more than one abstract/ research paper. However, the final decision as to the presentation rest with the college.

11. Can I participate in the conference without presenting a paper? Will I receive a certificate of participation?

Yes, one can participate in the conference without presenting a paper as a non-paper presenter and shall be provided with a certificate of participation. They can also avail a discount of 20% in the registration fees.

12. Is there any accommodation facility being provided for conference participants?

Accommodation and travel costs must be arranged by participants. However, college will be happy to assist the participants to identify suitable accommodations, if desired.

13. Can anyone else present research paper authored by me? If yes, who is authorized to do so?

Only authors and co-authors are authorized to present the paper.
