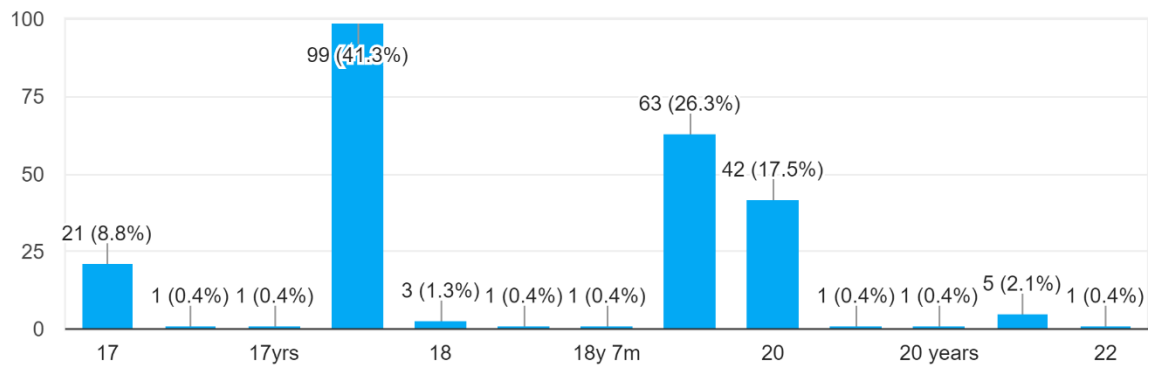

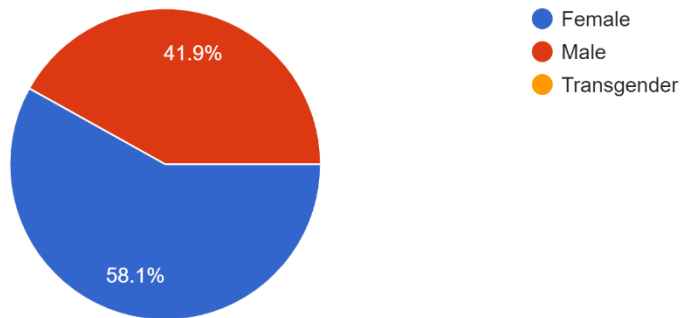

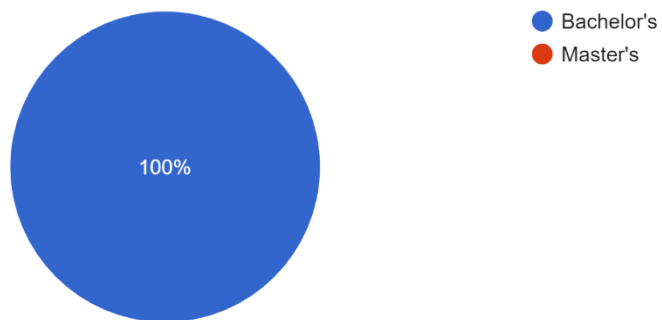

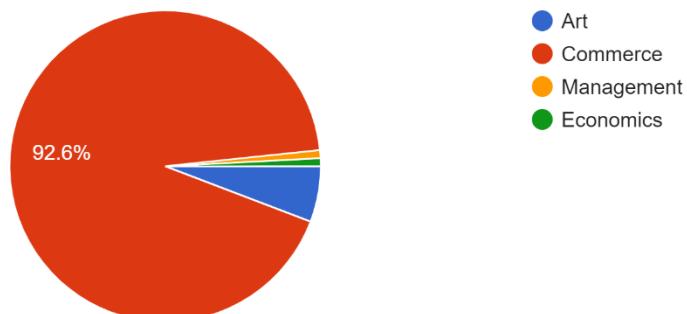
What degree program are you pursuing now?

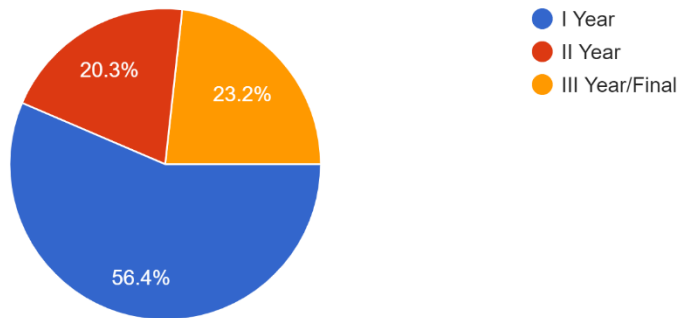

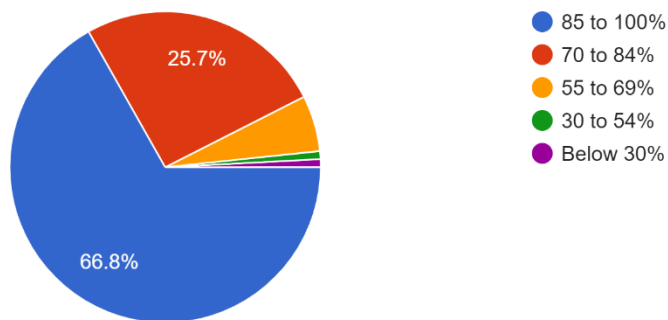

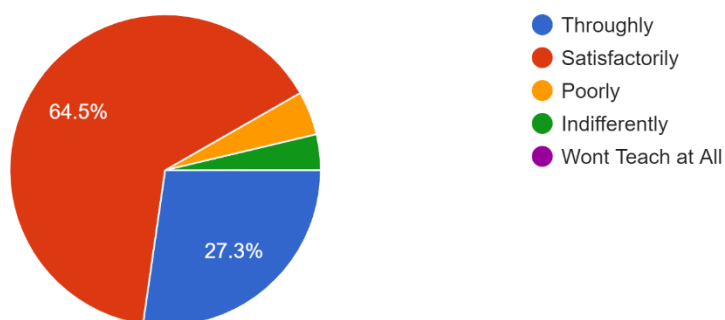

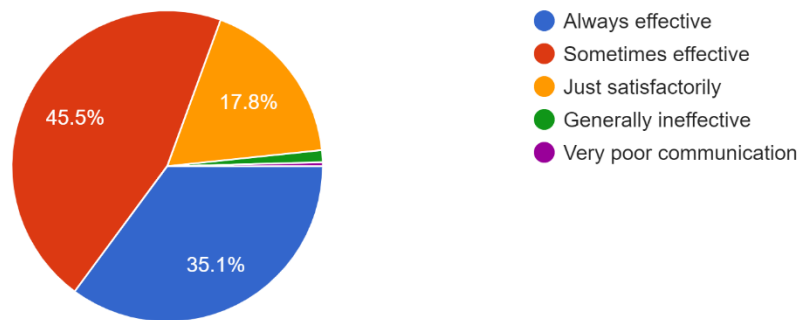

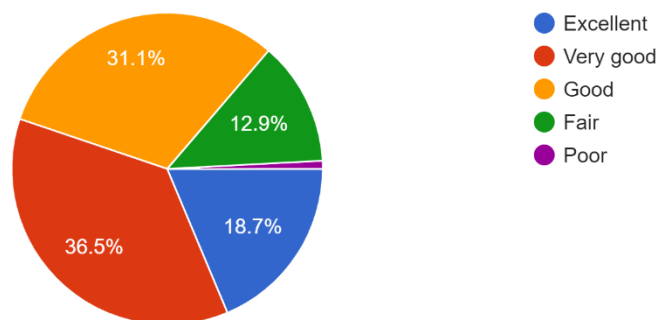

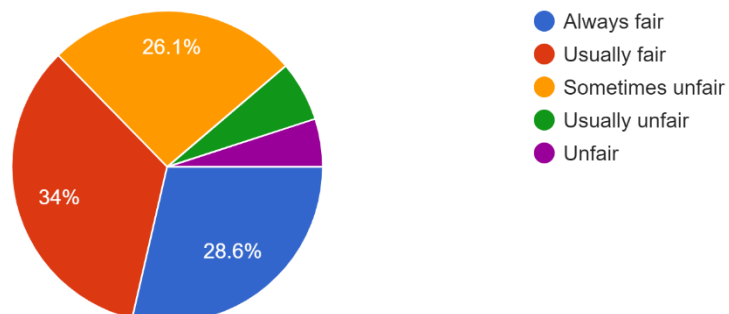

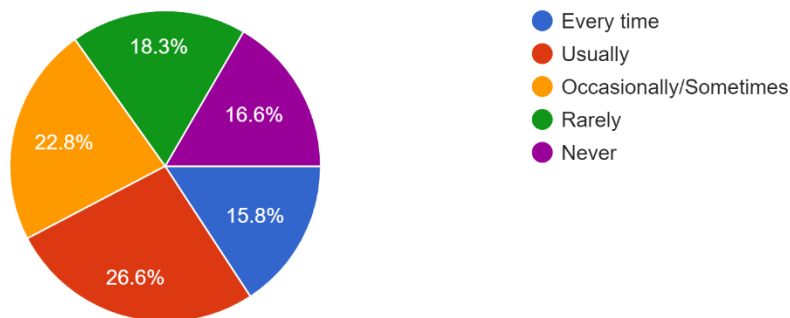

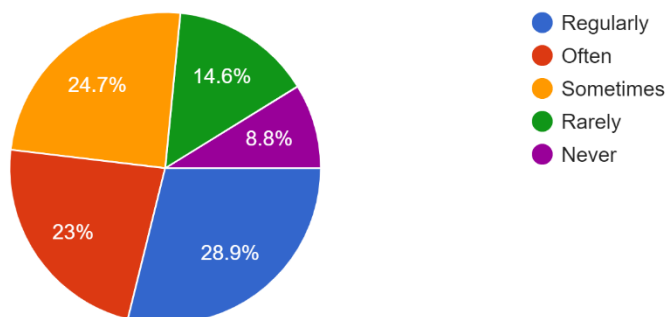

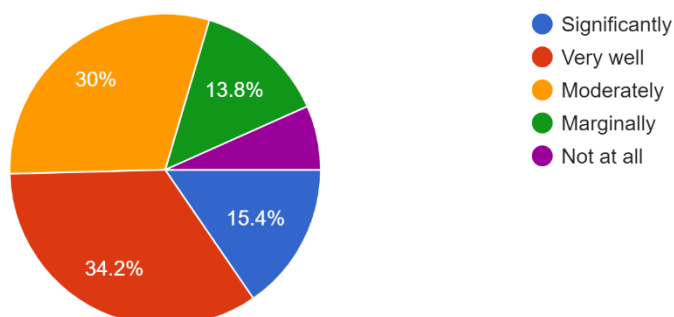

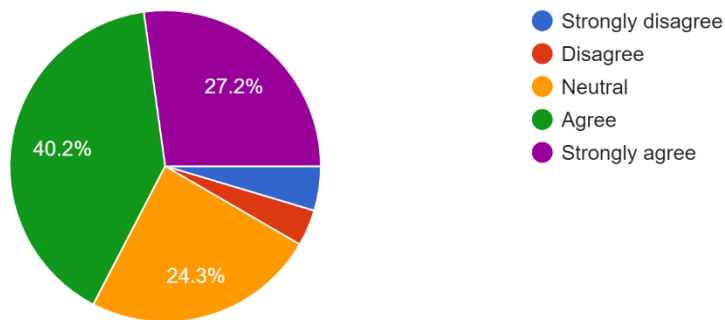

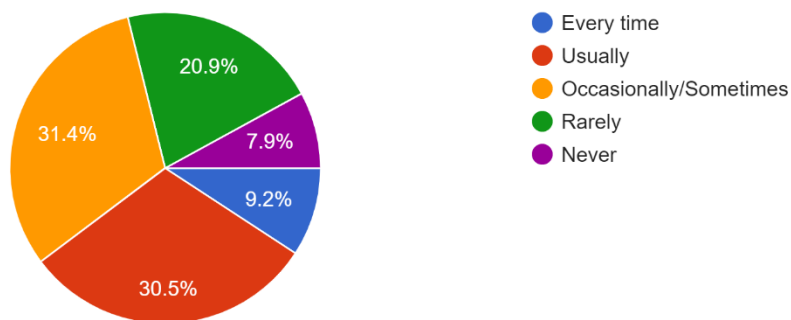

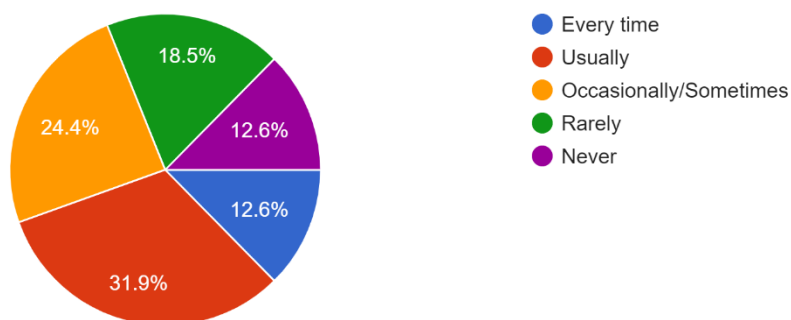

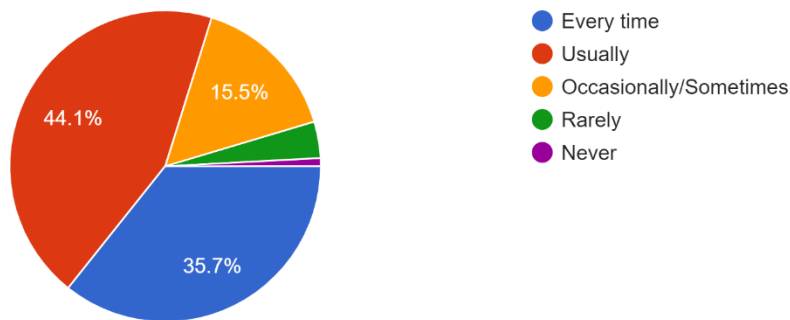

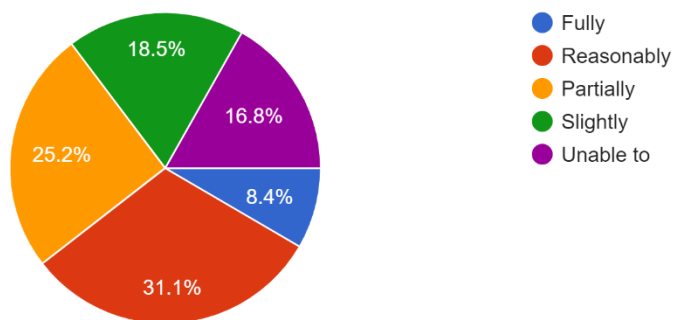

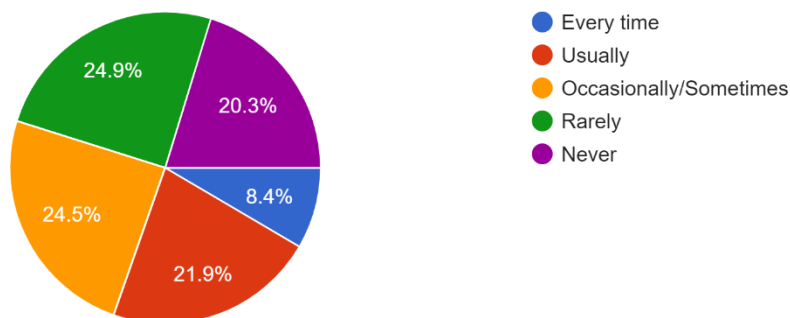

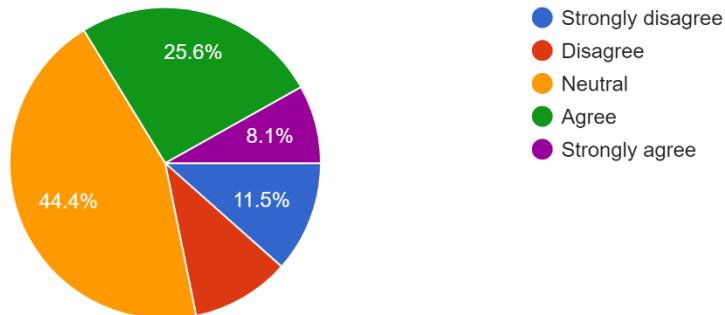

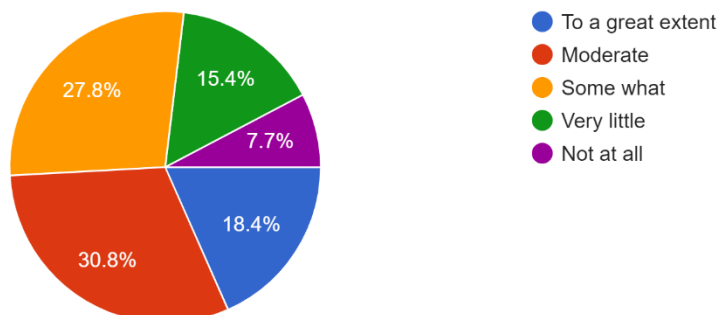

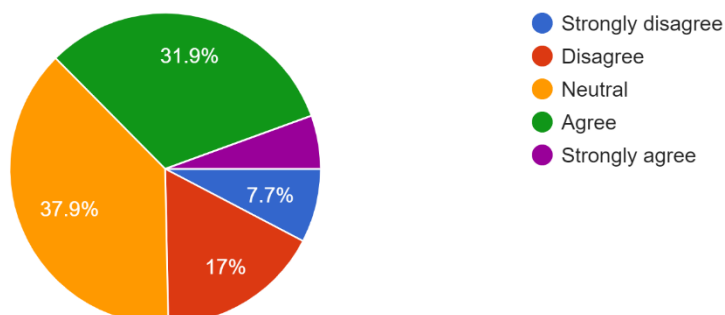

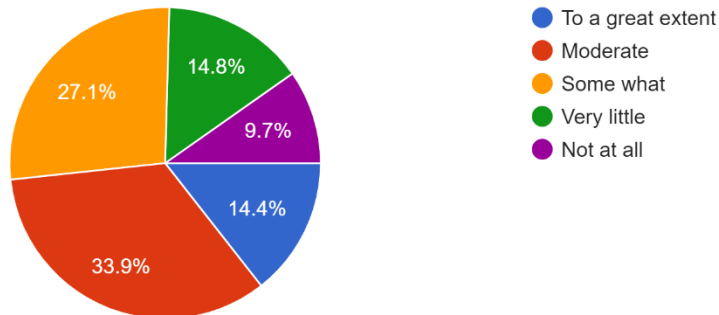

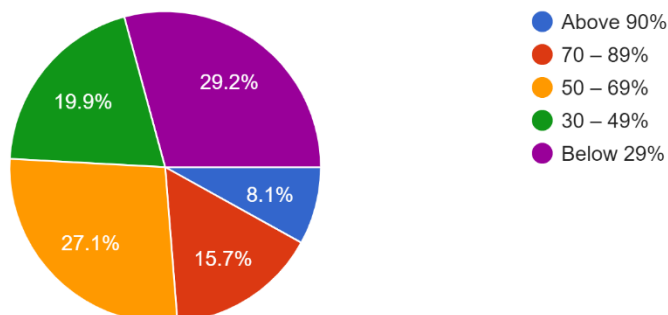
