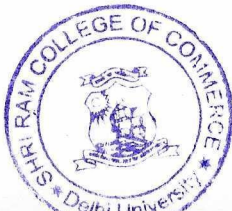

(c) Only one handmade poster per candidate is allowed to be fixed on the wall of democracy located in front of College Office. The use of paper for canvassing is not permitted. Recommendations of Lyngdoh Committee will be in force.



- (d) The Code of Conduct, Constitution of DUSU, decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India regarding Students' Union Election "University of Kerala v. Council, Principals, Colleges, Kerala and others" (Lyngdoh Committee Recommendations), Hon'ble Delhi High Court order dated 29.05.2018 and dated 11.11.2024 in W.P. (C) No. 7824/2017 titled Prashant Manchanda v. Union of India & Ors. (Defacement Case), The Delhi Prevention of Defacement of Property Act, 2007 and NGT order may be seen on DU and College Website.
- (e) Canvassing in the class rooms may be done only on 12th, 14th and 16th September 2026, provided teaching is not disrupted/disturbed.
